Other costs

- Additional visits from your Care Advisor (beyond the four annual visits allocated for Gold Care clients and two annual visits allocated for Silver Care clients) cost \$71 per hour, plus \$1.50 per kilometre travelled from our office to your home and back.
- If you have a preferred provider that is not already registered with us, we will invite them to establish a service agreement with us. This costs \$240 and is charged to your Home Care Package.
- Some service providers charge a travel fee on top of their fee for service provision. This can happen if a provider needs to travel long distances from their office to your home and back. Your Care Advisor will let you know if a travel fee applies before you book a service in. Travel fees vary between \$1 and \$6 per kilometre.
- Please note rates in the non-standard, Saturday, Sunday and public holiday section are the maximum rates that could be charged. Rates correct as of 1 July 2024. Rates are subject to change without notice if provider increases their fees over the current maximum rate.
